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The school of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences has as its purpose to provide a good quality education, both in the programs offered by the School, as well as in basic skills training courses and in Socio-humanistic training, so that our students develop critical-analytical, expression and communication skills, as well as their social and civic commitment. The School of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences is composed of four academic programs of professional formation: Psychology, Architecture, Social Communication and Journalism, and Design. Likewise, the School structures and administers three academic areas: Language, Socio-Humanistic Training and Philosophy, to contribute in the integral formation of the students of Universidad de Ibagué.

The Language Area was developed in 1992, with the creation of the School of Humanities at Universidad de Ibagué. This area responds to three fundamental axes: Reading and Writing in the University I and II, support to academic writing to students and teachers, from the E courses and the Spanish Center, and lastly, extension workshops in creative writing in agreement with the Ministry of Culture. University level Reading and Writing courses are transversal courses and they are focused on developing communicative skill in the native language, specifically in the academic writing dimension.
