The program has the best equipped laboratory and bank of tests in psychology in the department of Tolima, and a Center of Psychological Care which works as IPS, since 2007.

Manage and implement actions and projects in teaching, research and extension, articulating the basic and applied research, as well as the interdisciplinary component, in order to contribute from the national relevance and international standards to the commitment to the regional development.

Main responsibilities

The teacher will work in the psychology program in actions related to the strengthening of the following:

Teaching and Academic management: (30%)

- Contribute in teaching activities in the areas of basic psychological processes and research methodology.
- Contribute in teaching activities through the updating and implementation of courses in the areas of basic psychological processes and research methodology.
- Advise undergraduate thesis projects.
